It gives me great pleasure to write you once again. Lot of things are happening. Unfortunately Covid has launched itself into its second wave and people are suffering as families and the mortality rate is climbing. I request you all to take proper precautions while attending your OPD and I hope everyone of you has had the vaccine completed. Whatever be

the situation we should not forget our duty to the society and as before we should be at the forefront serving our people.

The state council meeting at at Erode on 21.03.2021 conducted by IMA Gobichettipalayam was a very business like meeting and a lot of issues were discussed. I congratulate the office bearers and members of IMA Gobichettipalayam for the excellent arrangements and hospitality.

The new office bearers of PPLSSS and FSS were announced. I wholeheartedly appreciate the great efforts of the outgoing teams and wish the very best to the new teams who have already taken over. I want to especially mention the way the office bearers of FSS conducted the scheme especially at a time when the scheme was going through difficulties and I thank them on behalf of all of you. In PPLSSS it has been decided to escalate the compensation award from five to ten lakhs and from ten to twenty lakhs by increasing the corresponding premia by Rs. 1000/- for five to ten lakhs and Rs. 2,000/- for ten to twenty lakhs. During the discussion the vexatious issue of confrontation between IMA and TNMC was brought to my notice and I assured the members that myself and other medical council members present in the meeting will take it up with the office bearers of the council and bring about an amicable solution. In the subsequent meeting in TNMC I was able to bring a rapport between IMA and TNMC and solve the issue amicably. It was decided to make available TIMA NEWS hard copy to members who want the hard copy and the branch office bearers were requested to provide a list of such members within two months. A committee was formed to formulate a common trust deed document to be followed by all branches whenever they formed a trust for their activities. This became necessary based on a representation submitted by the office bearers of IMA Gobichettipalayam. The committee would include Dr. S. Kanagasabhapathy, Dr. R. Palani swamy, Dr. S.S. Sukumar and Dr. B. Sridhar with myself and state honorary secretary as ex- officio members.

In the evening general body was conducted with good attendance.

On 22.03.2021, I attended an expert committee meeting of the state government. From there I proceeded to Cuddalore to inaugurate a new hospital on 24.03.2021.

On 25.03.2021, I attended a virtual meeting of Building Committee of national IMA.

On 28.03.2021, myself and other senior leaders of the project committee visited a few places in Chennai for considering purchase - no decision has been taken so far. On the same evening myself Dr. A.K. Ravi Kumar and Dr. B. Sridhar participated in a function organised by IMA Vellore to honour the Covid warriors that included all categories of health care workers. I appreciate and congratulate IMA Vellore for the excellent gesture.

On 03.04.2021, I attended a virtual meeting of medico legal seminar. On 04.04.2021, I attended a virtual meeting of South Zone Bioethics. On the same day I attended another virtual meeting of national level congenital deafness screening program for which Dr. C. N. Raja is the Chairman.

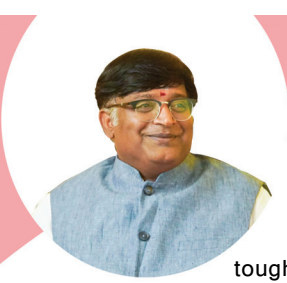

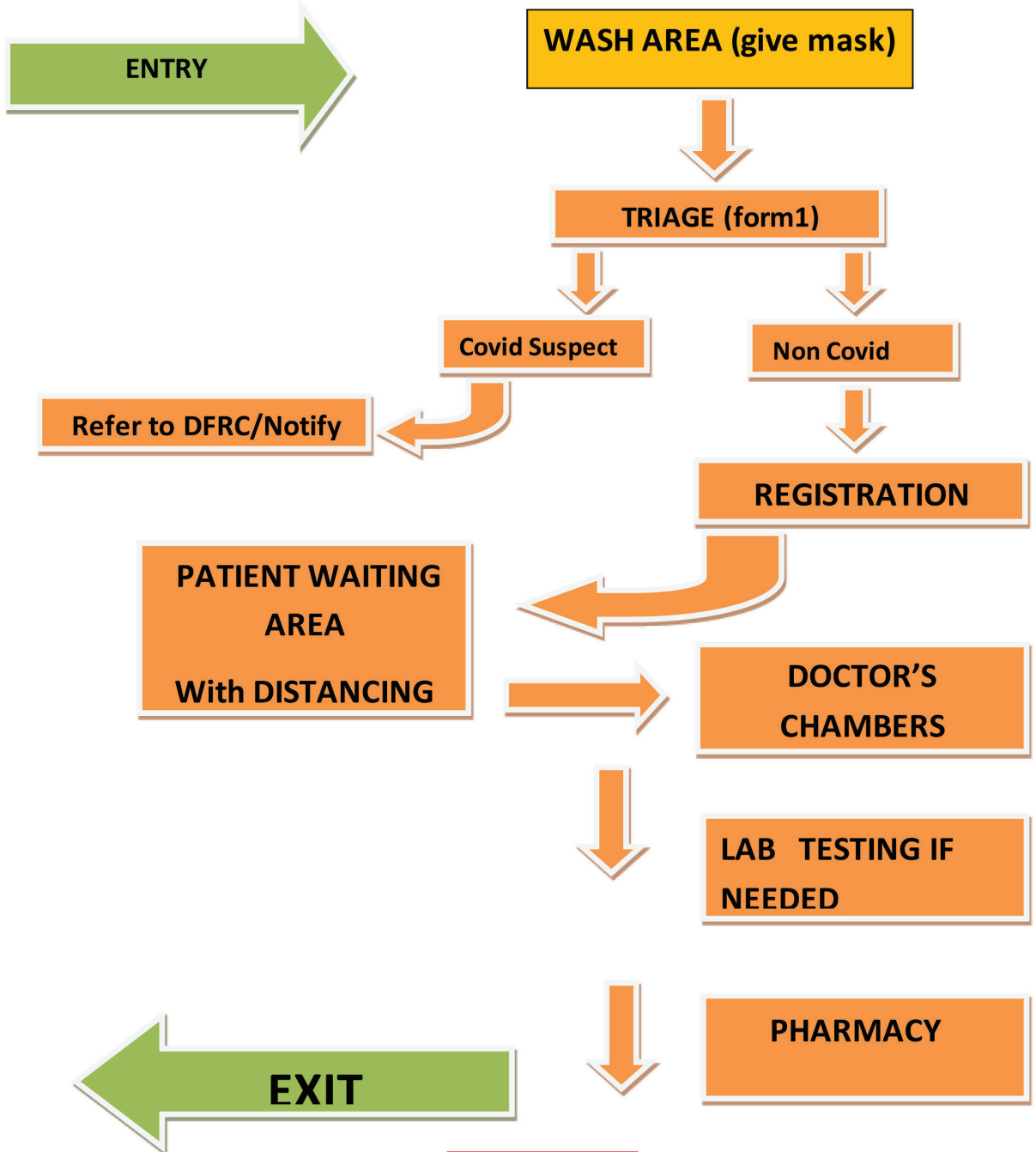

CLINICIAN PRACTICING GUIDELINES



Norms For Washing Area:

1. Water/ Soap/ preferably Elbow tap for hand wash (all the patients who are coming to the clinic should wash their hand and feet with soap and water.)
2. Tissues to wipe.
3. Posters on Hand Wash Techniques
4. 3 Ply mask to be provided before patient enters the Triage area

Norms for Registration Area

1. Prefer Appointment system and only one patient at a time
2. No attenders if the patient is stable
3. Patient enters the registration room with mask
4. Physical distancing should be maintained 4 feet from patient to patient and patient to staff preferably a barricade.
5. The staff manning this area can use a three layer mask / face shield ,gloves.
6. Sanitize the hand of each patient
7. Details of the patient to be collected as per the form 1A (annexure)
8. Document all the details in the form as well as in the Register or computer.
9. Do not hand over the Form to Patient.
10. Send the form to Doctors chamber.
11. Fee can be collected preferably by electronic transfer/ cash by non touch technique in to a box with formalin.

Norms For Waiting Area

1. Prefer not to make the patient wait.
2. Mark the areas with proper distancing of 3 to 4 feet.
3. Stool without arms preferred.
4. Not more than 10 patients in a well ventilated 400 sq ft room at a time.

Meningitis in Clinical Practice

Introduction

Meningitis and Encephalitis are real neurological Emergencies in any acute care hospital. The percentage of CNS infections in any acute care institute varies from 3% to 5% depending upon the season and geographical location. Patients with meningitis have nuchal rigidity, headache, photophobia and fever. Patients with encephalitis have disruption of cognitive function that may include altered consciousness, disorientation, behavioural or speech difficulties along with focal neurological signs such as convulsions or hemiparesis. In reality the majority of infections cause a combination of symptoms labelled as meningo encephalitis.

Aseptic Meningitis

Aseptic meningitis is often a viral infection and typically produces lymphocytic pleocytosis, normal glucose, mildly elevated protein, negative gram stain and sterile bacterial cultures. Similar CSF findings may occur in partially treated bacterial meningitis or para meningeal foci such as epidural, subdural or brain abscesses. Low CSF glucose may be seen in

- Tuberculous meningitis
- Cryptococcal meningitis



- Syphilitic meningitis
- Neuro sarcoidosis
- Meningeal carcinomatosis

Bacterial Meningitis

Commonest organisms causing bacterial infections includes Streptococcus pneumoniae, Neisseria meningitidis, Hemophilus influenzae, and Listeria monocytogenes. When the patient is not willing for informed consent for lumbar puncture, blood culture should be obtained before antibiotics are given. Approximately 50% of patients with bacterial meningitis have a positive blood culture.

Culture of CSF will be probably positive for hours after starting antibiotics.

The most common gram negative bacilli causing meningitis in young children includes Klebsiella species, Escherichia coli and Pseudomonas species account for 75% to 90% gram negative bacillary meningitis. Eighty percent of gram negative meningitis occurs in conjunction with head trauma or neurosurgical procedures. Gram negative bacilli and Staphylococci are the most common organisms causing meningitis after neurosurgical procedures. But any kind of bacteria and even

fungi such as candida species can gain access to the subarachnoid region and meninges.

Recurrent bacterial meningitis can occur in individuals with anatomic communication with paranasal sinuses, nasopharynx, middle ear, congenital midline dermal sinus tracts or prosthetic devices such as VP Stunts. Immunologic defects such as hypogammaglobulinemia, splenectomy, leukemia, lymphomas, sickle cell anemia and Complement deficiencies can predispose to recurrent bacterial meningitis.

Treatment of Bacterial Meningitis

Bacterial meningitis should be treated in Intensive care unit with maintaining blood pressure and treating septic shock with fluid replacement and pressor therapy. Choosing the right antibiotic that is known both to be bactericidal for the suspected organism as well as the ability to enter the CSF in effective amount.

Empirical therapy of Bacterial Meningitis

Age of the patient	Antibiotic of choice
0-4 weeks	Cefotaxime and Ampicillin
4-12 weeks	Ceftriaxone or Ceftazidime plus, Ampicillin plus, Dexamethasone
3 months to 18 years	Ceftriaxone or Ceftazidime plus Vancomycin plus Dexamethasone
18 - 50 years	Ceftriaxone or Ceftazidime plus Vancomycin plus Ampicillin
More than 50 years	Ceftriaxone or ceftazidime plus, Vancomycin plus, Ampicillin
Immunocompromised Individual	Vancomycin plus Ampicillin And Ceftazidime

Duration of Antibiotic Therapy

Most cases of bacterial meningitis should be treated for a period of 10-14 Days except when there is a persistent Para meningeal focus of infection (CSOM or Chronic sinusitis) Antibiotics should be administered in full doses parenterally (Intravenously only) throughout the period of treatment. Repeated Lumbar punctures are not necessary to assess the effects of therapy as long as there is progressive clinical improvement.

Duration of Steroid Therapy

All childhood meningitis regime should include Iv. Dexamethasone in high doses as 0.2mg / kg tds for 4 to 7 Days.

Recommended doses of Iv. Antibiotics

- Iv. Ampicillin 12 grams / day x 4 divided doses
- Iv. Cefepime 4 to 6 grams / day x 3 divided doses
- Iv. Cefotaxime 12grams / day x 4 divided doses
- Iv. Ceftazidime 6 grams / day x 3 divided dose
- Iv. Ceftriaxone 4 grams / day x 2 divided doses
- Iv. Linezolid 1200 mg / day x 2 divided doses
- Iv. Meropenem 6 grams / day x 3 divided doses
- Iv. Penicillin G 24 million units / day x 4 divided doses
- Iv. Vancomycin 2 - 4 grams / day x 12th Hourly

Prognosis of Bacterial Meningitis

Mortality rate of uncomplicated meningitis ranges from 5-15 percent depending upon the organism. Fulminant meningitis with meningococcus has high mortality rate because of the shock associated with adreno cortical haemorrhages (Waterhouse Friderichsen Syndrome). Mortality rates are higher in neonatal meningitis (40-70%).

In adults the presence of bacteremia, coma, seizures, alcoholism, diabetes mellitus, associated malignancy and Head injury, all worsen the prognosis.

The trial of pneumococcal meningitis, pneumonia, and endocarditis (Osler's triad) has a particularly high fatality rate. ■

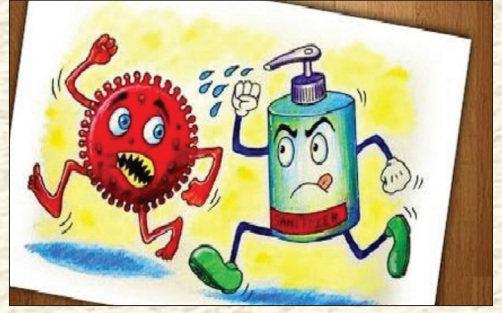

REACHING THE ZERO MALARIA TARGET

This year, WHO and partners will mark World Malaria Day by celebrating the achievements of countries that are approaching – and achieving – malaria elimination. They provide inspiration for all nations that are working to stamp out this deadly disease and improve the health and livelihoods of their populations.

On 21 April, WHO will publish a new report highlighting successes and lessons learned among the “E-2020” group of malaria-eliminating countries. Despite the challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic, a number of these countries reported zero indigenous malaria cases in 2020, while others made impressive progress in their journey to becoming malaria-free.

In the face of a dual threat of antimalarial drug resistance and COVID-19, countries of the Greater Mekong subregion have also made major strides towards their shared goal of elimination by 2030. In the 6 countries of the subregion, the reported number of malaria cases fell by 97% between 2000 and 2020. Malaria deaths were reduced by more than 99% in the same period of time.

Ahead of World Malaria Day, country leaders, frontline health workers and global partners will come together in a virtual forum to share experiences and reflections on efforts to reach the target of zero malaria. The event will be co-hosted by WHO and the RBM Partnership to End Malaria on 21 April. ■

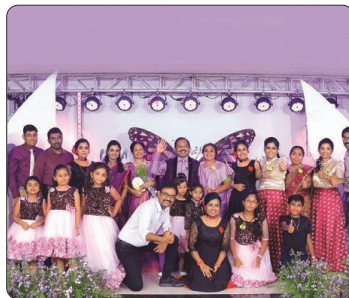

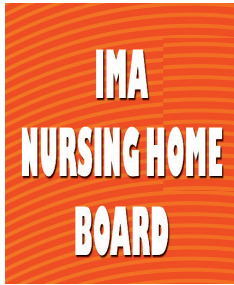

THE SECOND WAVE OF COVID HA COME TO OUR SHORES

Since March 5th 2021, Tamil Nadu has added 2,736 active cases and count is only going up. On March 10, it reported 671 cases, and the number of active cases increased to 4,207. On March 14, 795 cases were reported. This increased to 836 on March 15 while the number of active cases rose to 5,149. On March 17, the cases State reported 945 new case, and on Friday this increased to 1,087 cases with the number of active cases standing at 6,690.

Director of Public Health Dr.T.S. Selva vinayagam said the cases will continue to rise till people follow Covid-19 protocols, wear face masks and maintain social distancing. "Till all eight crore people wear face masks, this will continue and this is the message," he said. The Health Department is taking all measures to control the spread of the infection, he added. The Health Secretary J. Radhakrishnan on Wednesday had said

that the Health Department would continue to raise awareness on Covid appropriate behaviour.

The current trends are forcing hospitals that were slowly starting to treat more non-Covid cases to prepare for a potential second wave of infection. Even though vaccination has started peoples hesitation to get them and restricted availability is not breaking the chain. The New Wave possibly can bring new strains of the virus which are more resistant to treatment. As healthcare practitioners we should not let our guards down. We should follow all strict COVID preventive measures in our Hospitals and should follow all the SOP's developed for both inpatient and outpatient care. Hospitals which have space and who have already had the experience of running a COVID care centre should be prepared to start again to combat the rising cases in our state. ■

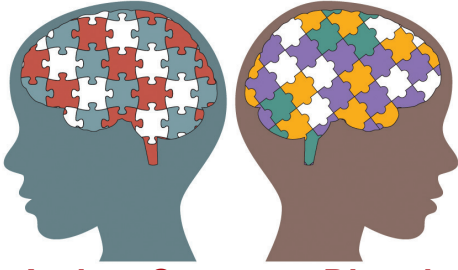
