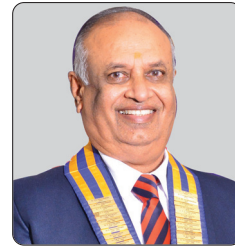

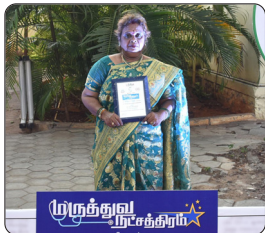

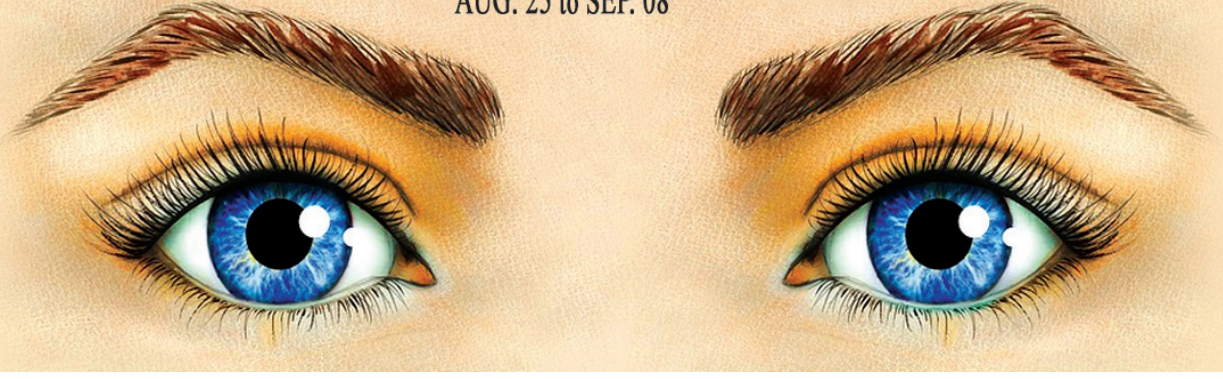

கண்ணின் மையப் பகுதியில் கறுப்பாகத் தெரியும் கண்ணாடி போன்ற ஒளி ஊடுருவக்கூடிய கண்ணின் மேல்படலமே கருவிழி ஆகும்.

## எப்படி கருவிழி பாதிப்பு ஏற்பட்டு பார்வை யிழப்பு (corneal blindness) ஏற்படுகிறது?

கருவிழியானது அடிபடுதல், பிறவிக்குறைபாடு, கிருமி பாதிப்பு, கருவிழிப் புண் மற்றும் குழந்தைப் பருவத்தில் சத்து குறைபாடு (வைட்டமின் A சத்து குறைபாடு) போன்ற காரணங்களால் கருவிழித் தழும்பு (corneal scar) உண்டாகி, கருவிழியின் ஒளி ஊடுரும் தன்மை பாதித்து பார்வையிழப்பு ஏற்படும்.

## கருவிழி பாதிப்பினால் பார்வையிழந்தவர்களுக்கு எப்படிப் பார்வையைத் திரும்பக் கொடுக்க இயலும்?

கண் தானம் செய்யும் நபரிடம் இருந்து பெறப்படும் கருவிழியை கருவிழி பாதிப்பினால் பார்வை இழந்தவர்களுக்கு பொருத்தும் கருவிழி மாற்று அறுவைச் சிகிச்சை (corneal Transplantation) மூலம் பார்வையைத் திரும்பக் கொடுக்கலாம்.

## யார் கண்தானம் செய்யலாம்?

ஒரு வயதுக்கு மேல் உள்ளவர்கள் கண் தானம் செய்யலாம். நாம் வாழும்போதே நம் கண்களை தானம் செய்ய விருப்பப் படிவம் மற்றும் உறுதிமொழி எடுத்துக்கொள்ளலாம். நம்முடைய விருப்பத்தை நம்முடைய உறவினரிடம் கூறி, நம்முடைய வாழ்நாட்களுக்குப் பிறகு நம் கண்களை தானமாகக் கொடுக்கலாம்.

## சர்க்கரை நோயாளிகள் கண் தானம் செய்யலாமா?

சர்க்கரை நோய், இரத்தக் கொதிப்பு நோய் உள்ளவர்கள் மற்றும் இருதய நோய் உள்ளவர்களும் தங்களுடைய கண்களைத் தானமாகக் கொடுக்கலாம். கண்களில் நரம்புப் பாதிப்பு (optic nerve disease), விழித்திரை பாதிப்பு (Retinal disease) உள்ளவர்கள்கூட கண் தானம் செய்யலாம். கண்புரை அறுவைச் சிகிச்சை (cataract surgery) செய்து கொண்டவர்களும் மற்றும் கிட்டப்பார்வை, தூரப் பார்வை கண்ணாடி அணிந்திருப்பவர்களும் கண் தானம் செய்யலாம்.

## யார் கண்களை தானம் செய்ய இயலாது?

காரணம் தெரியாத இறப்பு, கண்ணில் கிருமி பாதிப்பு உள்ளவர்கள், கருவிழி பாதிப்பு உள்ளவர்கள் (CORNEAL DISEASE), கருவிழி அறுவைச் சிகிச்சை செய்தவர்கள், வெறிநாய் கிருமி நோய் (RABIES), எய்ட்ஸ் நோய், சிபிலிஸ் நோய், மஞ்சள்காமாலை கிருமி நோய் உள்ளவர்கள் (Hepatitis), புற்று நோயால் பாதிக்கப்பட்டுள்ள



வர்கள், பல்நோக்கு நோய்கிருமி தாக்கியவர்கள் (septicemia) கண்களை தானம் செய்ய இயலாது.

இறந்தவர்களின் கண்களைத் தானமாக எடுக்கும்போது அவர்கள் இரத்த மாதிரி சேகரிக்கப்பட்டு, அவர்களுக்கு எச்.ஐ.வி., மஞ்சள்காமாலை கிருமி மற்றும் மற்ற கிருமிகள் உள்ளனவா? எனப் பரிசோதனைக்கு உட்படுத்தப்பட்டு, பிறகு தான் கருவிழி மாற்று அறுவைச் சிகிச்சைக்குப் பயன்படுத்தப்படும்.

## இறந்த பிறகு எத்தனை மணி நேரத்திற்குள் கண்களை எடுக்க வேண்டும்?

ஒருவர் இறந்த பிறகு 6 மணி நேரத்திற்குள் அவர்களுடைய கண்களை எடுத்து பாதுகாக்க வேண்டும்.

## கண் தானம் செய்ய விரும்பும் நாம் செய்ய வேண்டியவை என்ன?

முதலில் நம் வாழ்க்கைக்குப் பின் நம் கண்களை தானம் செய்ய விருப்பம் இருந்தால், அதற்கான விருப்பப் படிவத்தை அருகில் உள்ள அரசு மற்றும் அரசு உதவி பெறும் கண் வங்கியில் பெற்று பதிவு செய்துகொள்ள வேண்டும். பதிவு செய்த விவரத்தை மற்றும் நம் விருப்பத்தை நம் குடும்ப உறுப்பினர்களிடம் தெரிவிக்க வேண்டும். அந்தக் கண் வங்கியின் தொலைபேசி எண் நமக்கும், நம் குடும்ப உறுப்பினர்களுக்கும் தெரிந்திருக்க வேண்டும். நாம் இறக்க நேரிட்டால், உடனடியாக நம் குடும்ப உறுப்பினர்கள் அந்தக் கண்தான வங்கிக்குத் தொடர்பு கொண்டு, அவர்கள் நம் கண்களை தானமாக பெற்றுக் கொள்வார்கள்.

## கண் தானத் தூதுவராக நாம் ஆகலாமா?

நம் உறவினர், நம் நண்பர், அவர்கள் குடும்ப உறுப்பினரோ அல்லது நமக்குத் தெரிந்தவரோ இறந்துவிட்டால், இறந்தவர்களின் குடும்ப உறுப்பினர்களிடம் கண் தானம் பற்றி எடுத்துக்கூறி, அவர்கள் சம்மதம் பெற்று கண் வங்கி அல்லது

கண்தான மையத்தைத் தொடர்பு கொண்டு, கண்களை தானமாகக் கொடுக்க உதவுவது; மேலும் எங்கு சென்றாலும் கண் தானம் பற்றி விழிப்புணர்வை ஏற்படுத்தும் நபரே கண்தானத் தூதுவராவார். கண் தானம் செய்வதை ஒவ்வொரு குடும்பத்தின் வழக்கமாக மாற்றுவோம்.

**மருத்துவமனை கருவிழி வேட்டை என்றால் என்ன?**

மருத்துவமனைகளில் விபத்து மற்றும் அவசரச் சிகிச்சைப் பிரிவு மற்றும் இருதய அவசரச் சிகிச்சைப் பிரிவுகளில் ஆபத்தான தறுவாயில் உள்ள நோயாளிகள் இறக்க நேரிட்டால், அங்குள்ள கண்தான ஆலோசகர்கள் அவர்கள் குடும்பத்தினரிடம் கண் தானம் பற்றி விளக்கி கருவிழியைத் தானமாகப் பெறும் செயலே மருத்துவமனை கருவிழி வேட்டை ஆகும். மருத்துவமனைகளில் மூளைச்சாவு ஏற்பட்டு உடல் தானம் செய்யும்போது, கண்களையும் தானமாகப் பெற்றுக்கொள்ளலாம் .

**கண் தானம் எடுப்பதற்கு முன் நாம் செய்ய வேண்டியது என்ன?**

கண் தானம் பெறுவதற்கான அரசு அல்லது அரசு உதவி பெறும் கண் வங்கியிலிருந்து மருத்துவக் குழு வருவதற்கு முன், இறந்தவர்களின் கண்களின் இமைகள் மூடி இருக்கும்படி வைக்க வேண்டும். கண்களினமீது ஈரமான பஞ்சை வைத்து மூடி வைக்க வேண்டும். இறந்தவர்கள் அருகில் இருக்கும் மின் விசிறியை அணைக்க வேண்டும். தலைப்பகுதியை 6" அளவு உயர்த்தி வைக்க வேண்டும்.

**கண்களை எடுத்த பிறகு அதனை எப்படிப் பாதுகாக்க வேண்டும்?**

எடுக்கப்பட்ட கண்களை கண்தான மையம் (Eye donation centre) அல்லது கண் வங்கியில் (Eye Bank) அறுவை அரங்கம் போல் கிருமித் தொற்று இல்லாத அறையில் வைத்து, அந்தக் கண்களின் கருவிழியை மட்டும் தனியாகப் பிரித்தெடுத்து அதனை பாதுகாக்கக்கூடிய திரவத்தில் வைத்து கருவிழி மாற்று அறுவைச் சிகிச்சைக்குப் பயன்படுத்தலாம். ஒரு வருடம் வரை ஒரு கருவிழியை கண் வங்கியில் பாதுகாத்து வைக்க முடியும்.

**கண் தானம் மூலம் கிடைத்த கண்களை எப்படி அறுவைச் சிகிச்சைக்குப் பயன்படுத்துவார்கள்?**

தானம் பெற்ற கண்ணின் கருவிழி மற்றும் கண்ணின் வெளிப்புற வெண்படலம் (sclera) மட்டுமே பயன்படுத்த இயலும். கருவிழியினால் ஏற்படும் பார்வையிழப்பை மட்டுமே கருவிழி மாற்று அறுவைச் சிகிச்சையினால் சரிசெய்ய இயலும். கண்ணின் வெளிப்புற வெண்படலம் (sclera) செயற்கைக் கண் பொருத்தும் அறுவைச் சிகிச்சையில் பயன்படுத்தப்படும். கருவிழியைத் தவிர கண்ணின் மற்ற பகுதிகள் ஆராய்ச்சிக்குப் பயன்படுத்தப்படும்.

**கருவிழி மாற்று அறுவைச் சிகிச்சை மூலம் ஒருவருக்கு பார்வை கிடைக்கிறதா?**

இந்தியாவில் கருவிழி மாற்று அறுவைச் சிகிச்சைகள் வெற்றி கரமாக நடைபெற்று வருகின்றன. அவர்களில் 90 சதவீதம் பேருக்கு பார்வை திரும்பக் கிடைக்கிறது. ஒருவர் செய்யும் கண் தானத்தால் (ஒரு ஜோடி கண்கள்) இரு பார்வையற்ற நபர்களுக்கு பார்வை கிடைக்கிறது.

**வாருங்கள்... ஒளிவிளக்கு ஏற்றுவோம்!**

தற்போது இந்தியாவில் கரு விழிப் பாதிப்பினால் முழுவதும் பார்வை இழந்தவர்கள் (Total Blind) 1,20,000. அவர்களுடன் 20,000 பேர் ஒவ்வொரு வருடமும் புதிதாகச் சேர்கின்றனர். இந்தியா முழுவதும் ஆண்டுதோறும் அரசு மற்றும் அரசு சாரா கண் வங்கியின் மூலம் 50,000 முதல் 55,000 கண்கள் தானமாக பெறப்படுகின்றன. நம்முடைய தேவையில் ஐம்பது சதவீத கண்களை மட்டுமே தானமாகப் பெற முடிகிறது. கண் தானம் பற்றிய விழிப்புணர்வு கிராமப்புற மக்களிடையே மட்டுமின்றி, நகர்ப்புற மக்களிடையேயும் குறைவாக உள்ளது.

கண் தானத்தின் அவசியம் குறித்தும், கருவிழி பாதிப்பினால் முழுவதும் பார்வை இழந்தவர்களை கருவிழி மாற்று அறுவைச் சிகிச்சை செய்ய ஆலோசனை வழங்கி, அவர்களைப் பரிந்துரை செய்தல் குறித்தும், கருவிழி பாதிப்பு வராமல் தடுப்பது குறித்தும், வைட்டமின் 'A' அவசியம் குறித்தும் விழிப்புணர்வை ஏற்படுத்துவதே நோக்கமாகக் கொண்ட தேசிய கண்தான இரு வாரத்தை மாபெரும் விழிப்புணர்வு விழாவாகக் கொண்டாடி பார்வையற்ற உள்ளங்களில் மறு பார்வை என்ற ஒளிவிளக்கு ஏற்றுவோம் வாருங்கள்!

# EYE

## DONATION FORTNIGHT



Every year from August 25<sup>th</sup> to September 8<sup>th</sup> is nationally observed as “The Eye Donation Fortnight”. This fortnight is observed to create awareness and to motivate people to donate their eyes. It was introduced in 1986 by Mr. Rajiv Gandhi, the then prime minister who pledged his eyes.

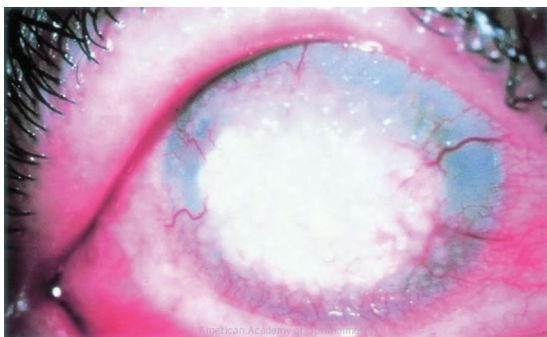
Even though this being the 35<sup>th</sup> year we have not registered worthwhile increase in the number of eye donations. This movement is still in a very insignificant stage in India. In our country, we have an estimated 6.8 million people with corneal blindness (90% are below the age of 45 years of which 60% are below the age of 12 years). In addition to this, 20,000 new cases are added to this figure ever year. As against an annual requirement of 2 million corneas, the current cornea procurement rate is 55,000 per year. Based on 10.2 million deaths annually the total collection of eyes stand at < 0.5% of all deaths. With a goal of 100,000 transplants and utilization of 50%, the target of consenting donors is 100,000/year which translates to 1% of all deaths. Thus the demand for corneal tissue is far greater than its supply. Surgeons are handicapped since adequate number of donor eyes is not available for corneal transplantation. Till date, no other artificial substitute has been made available which can be used for corneal grafting.

The Eye Bank Association of India (EBAI) is a voluntary organization helping persons with corneal blindness by facilitating eye donations. At present we have 175 eye banks in India, out of which only 51 are actually functioning. It is learnt that only 30 % of Indian population is aware of eye donation and only 0.1 % of them have pledged their eyes. Thus the need of the hour is to have a strategy to meet the acute demand by making good use of the available eye banking service through adequate publicity to increase the awareness

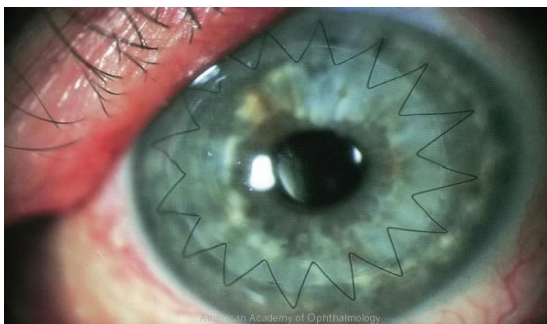
of the public and creating proper facilities for tissue procurement and improved storage.

### Eye donation – World scenario

In United States of America they have legislation for eye donation – *The Presumed Consent Law* which was introduced in 1975. This concept has legal sanction, where, if the dead person has not registered any objection to donate while alive, consent is presumed and eyes can be removed as required. This legislation has led to a manifold increase in the availability of corneal tissue. In India we still do not have such legislation; the government should introduce the concept of “*presumed consent*” to boost eye donations. Another area of legislation is the “*required request law*” wherein it becomes mandatory for all health care staff institutions coming into contact with bereaved families to make a request for eye donation. This requires legal sanction.

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

#### 1. *What is corneal blindness?*

Cornea is the clear transparent surface of the eye. Like a “window”, it allows light to enter the eye and to focus on the retina. Vision could be markedly reduced or lost if the cornea becomes “cloudy” or scarred. This condition is known as corneal blindness.

#### 2. *What are the causes of corneal blindness?*

Injuries to the eye, birth defects, malnutrition, infections, chemical burns, congenital disorders and complications of eye surgery.

#### 3. *Who can donate eyes?*

Eye donors could be of any age group, sex or religion.

- People who use spectacles, or having cataract, or have undergone eye surgery, diabetics, patients with high blood pressure, asthma patients, poor eye sight due to glaucoma or retinal disease and those without communicable diseases can also donate eyes.

#### 4. *Who cannot donate eyes?*

Persons with AIDS, Hepatitis B and C, Rabies, Septicemia, Acute leukemia (Blood cancer), Tetanus, Cholera, and Infectious diseases like Meningitis, Encephalitis and death due to an unknown cause cannot donate eyes.

#### 5. *What is corneal transplantation?*

A Corneal transplant is an operation that replaces a disc-shaped segment of an impaired or opaque cornea with a similar shaped clear cornea obtained from a human donor. More than 90 per cent of corneal transplant operations successfully restore the recipient’s vision.

## ***6. Can the whole eye of the donor be used transplanted?***

No. Only the cornea and the sclera can be transplanted. The whole eye can be used for valuable research and development.

## ***7. Will the donor's families pay or receive any fees?***

No. It is illegal to buy and sell human eyes, organs and tissues. Costs associated with eye procurement are absorbed by the eye bank.

## ***8. What happens after eye donation?***

- The donor's family receives a certificate of appreciation from the eye bank
- The eyes are taken to the eye bank and evaluated by a trained eye bank staff
- Tests are carried out and the tissue is sent to the corneal surgeon
- The waiting list is referred and then based on specified guidelines, the recipient is chosen
- Corneal transplant is performed
- Periodic follow-up of the recipient is done over time to ensure that the graft is successful.

## **Facts about eye donation**

- Eyes can be donated only after death
- Eyes must be removed within 4 - 6 hours after death
- The eye bank team will remove the eyes from the home of the deceased or from a hospital
- Eye removal does not delay the funeral since the entire procedure takes 20-30 minutes only
- The whole eye ball is removed
- Sight can be restored for two corneal blind persons from every good pair of corneas received

- A small quantity of blood will be drawn to rule out the presence of any communicable diseases
- Eye retrieval does not cause disfigurement
- Religions are for eye donation
- The identities of both the donor and the recipient are kept confidential

To donate eyes, the following procedures should be done by the relatives of the deceased

- Close the eye lids of the deceased
- Switch off the fan
- Raise the head of the deceased slightly by placing a pillow underneath
- In the event of death contact the nearest eye bank as quickly as possible.
- Give the correct address with specific landmarks and telephone number to enable the eye bank team locate the place easily
- If the death certificate from the physician is available, keep it ready
- Eye donation can be done only with the written consent of the next of kin in the presence of two witnesses

## **Your role as an individual in eye donation**

- Pledging your eyes - Register yourself in an eye bank
- Inform your family members about your wish
- Motivate your family members to donate as well.
- Inform the eye bank immediately when a death occurs in the family and help in the eye retrieval
- Motivating friends and relatives of the deceased to donate eyes
- To break social taboos

Now the incomplete data are given to the NHB District Coordinators to complete the process.

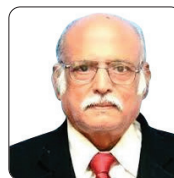
