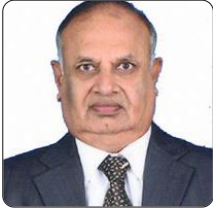

# Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19)

### Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19)

- ✦ Corona Virus infection causes fever, cough, myalgia and difficulty in breathing in humans.
- ✦ Outbreak of novel Corona virus infection has occurred in Wuhan province of China and spread to several countries. It is suspected to have spread to humans from animals.

### Disease Symptoms

- ✦ Fever, Cough
- ✦ Myalgia
- ✦ Difficulty in breathing

### Disease transmission

- ✦ Disease spreads from person-to-person directly through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs and sneezes (<20%).
- ✦ People also become infected by touching surfaces of hand railings of staircases and elevators, door handles, armrests of chairs, table surfaces and other surfaces like ticket counters contaminated by droplets generated by coughing or sneezing and then touching their mouth or nose or eyes (>80%).

### Preventive measures

- ✦ Frequent washing of hands with soap and water for atleast 30 seconds every time.
- ✦ To cover the face by a clean hand kerchief during coughing or sneezing.
- ✦ Children below 3 years and people above 70 years should stay away from public gatherings and overcrowded places.
- ✦ Standard disinfection practices should be followed in all Health care facilities.

### Treatment

- ✦ If you have symptoms like fever, cough, myalgia or breathlessness, take medical consultation
- ✦ Plenty of oral fluids particularly rice kanji with salt and ORS solution are recommended.

### For your Attention

- ✦ People are advised to avoid visiting affected areas, particularly foreign countries.
- ✦ People with fever, cough, cold and breathing difficulty are advised to stay away from public gatherings and overcrowded places.
- ✦ If the people who visited any foreign country recently develop symptoms like fever, cough or breathlessness they should report to near by Primary Health Centres or Government Hospitals.
- ✦ 30 plus age group people should check their blood pressure and sugar levels.

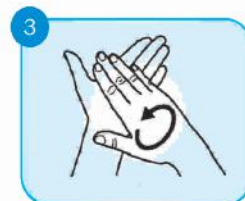

Wet hands with water



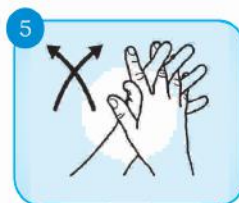
Apply enough soap



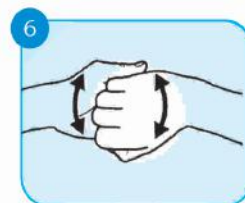
Rub hands palm to palm

Palm to palm with fingers interlaced



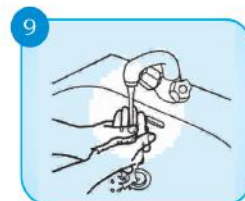
Back of fingers to opposing palms with fingers interlocked

Rinse hands with water and dry thoroughly with a single use towel.

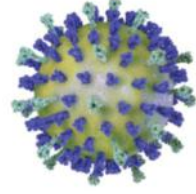

## **IMA TNSB - CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19)**

### **INSTRUCTIONS TO CLINICS AND HOSPITALS**

#### **“10 COMMANDMENTS”**

1. COVID-19 is a notifiable disease/ if not notified is punishable.
2. Notify the patients with the suspected following symptoms: Fever with any one of these signs like running nose, sore throat, dry cough, breathlessness and Diarrhea.
3. Provide the full contact details of patients with above symptoms/ travel history of the patient whether they come from the COVID19 affected areas to JDHS/ DDHS/ HI of your area or region.
4. Wherever possible have a separate fever clinic / Give appointments to the patients to avoid crowding in the OP.
5. Frequently clean doors, chairs, handles, cots & staircase railings, tabletops, etc., with disinfectants.
6. Provide Washing point with enough soap and water for incoming patients.
7. Keep disinfectant/ Hand rub in the front desk or OP for patients and attenders.
8. Have mask in the front desk or OP and give the mask to any patient with the above symptoms and attend to him immediately to avoid waiting in the OP.
9. Advice the Paramedic People and Health Care Professionals to wear surgical mask, to follow Hand Hygiene and Personal Protective Measures.
10. Only one attender with the Inpatient is allowed and no visitors are allowed to visit the inpatient.

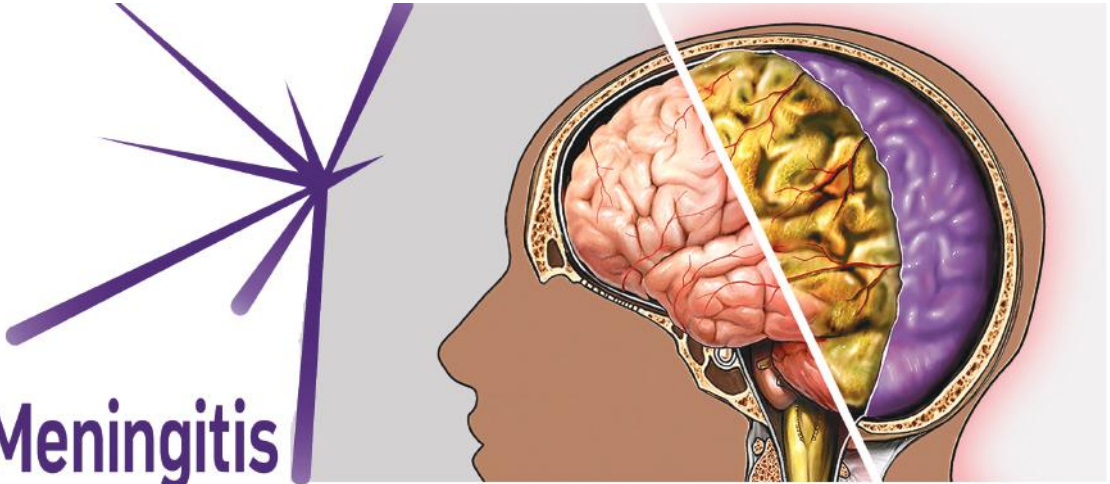

# Meningitis

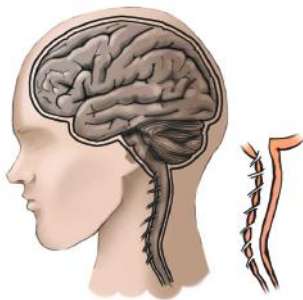
**M**eningitis is an acute inflammation of brain and spinal cord membranes. World Wide 8.7 Million people are affected with meningitis. In India about 1 million cases are reported per year. Meningitis is a leading cause of death among children below five years of age.

Most cases of meningitis are caused by viral infection, but bacterial, parasitic and fungal infection are other causes. Hospital based data reports that nearly 40 - 50% of meningitis result from HIB infection.

In India tuberculosis meningitis constitute majority of cases of meningitis. Symptoms of meningitis include fever, headache, vomiting, confusion, seizures, photosensitivity skin rashes and neck pain. On examination patient will have neck stiffness and kerning sign. New borns and infants may present with fever, constant crying, poor feeding, bulging fontanelle and irritability. viral causes include herpes simplex virus, HIV, mumps, west nile virus. Bacterial causes include mycobacterium tuberculosis, streptococcus, listeria, H.influenza, meningococcus etc. Fungal meningitis is uncommon and can be caused by cryptococcus in HIV patients. Meningitis can also result from non infectious causes such as chemical reactions, drug allergies, some types of cancer and inflammatory diseases such as sarcoidosis.

Bacterial meningitis is serious and can be fatal within days without prompt antibiotic treatment. Delayed treatment increases the risk of permanent brain damage or death. With prompt treatment, even patients with severe meningitis can have good recovery.

Meningitis can be prevented by washing your hands, practicing good hygiene and proper immunization. ■

2. Read the rules before allowing access. We blindly agree to all conditions just as we do before signing a loan agreement in a bank or mutual fund and later land up in trouble.
3. Download apps which are absolutely necessary only.
4. Ok google , Siri and Alexa are dangerous apps. Never download them . You are constantly being watched.

5. Amazon, fb, Watsapp are all linked. Just imagine how Amazon gives you an Offer blinking at you, when you open the phone after searching fr a particular product like a shoe. Or Resorts, travel guide pop up after you have searched a place, the day before.

6. It is necessary but use diligently.

7. Don't gift little children with expensive phones.

8. All apps have an option of Parental control. Use it.

9. In Watsapp settings, there is an option fr backup. You may OFF it.

10. While using your debit or credit cards, google asks if password should be stored. Type NO. Otherwise, it will be stored.

11. In short, With our consent and without our knowledge, we are sharing all personal information.

12. Never touch any link from any unknown person. Just touching it may lead them to gain access to all information stored in your device.

13. Bank never asks your details over phone, even fr KYC updating. Don't answer such calls.

14. Don't share your ATM pin no, CVV, expiry date etc. A new fraud asking for such details, saying your ATM card is blocked and that they need the details to activate your card has come up recently. Don't fall prey to it.

15. Another one is asking bank details for transfer of lottery money. They cash in on people's greed. Don't give in.

16. Latest fraud is copying data from WiFi enabled ATM cards. When the hacker comes near you with his hacking machine, it can transfer all your card details within seconds if it is kept unprotected in your bag or pocket. So, Keep your ATM card in lead pouches to protect them.

17. Never use free WiFi offered in public places like railway station, airport etc. Use your own Mobile data.

18. Save 3 numbers in Emergency call list. "19. Download Kavalan app. It will be very helpful in tricky and critical situations.

20. For children and adolescents, don't trust anyone. In 90% Of cases, they are abused by known persons only.

21. Don't be afraid to tell your parents or teacher when someone blackmails or threatens.

22. Don't allow anyone to take a nude photo or share such fotos.

23. Don't accept friend requests from people whom you do not know personally. For example, a person may have 2000 friends in fb but he may know only 500 of them personally. The rest of them are not known to him but bcoz he shares personal fotos and information in his fb page, they will get to know all about him.

24. Use social media securely and smart phones smartly.

# MEDICAL ASSOCIATIONS / NGOs ARE REQUIRED TO REGISTER UNDER SOCIETY / TRUST ACT

Every Association/NGO should have its own Constitution/MOU while registering with the respective authorities.

## **What is Constitution?**

A body of fundamental principles or established precedents according to which a state or other organization is acknowledged to be governed.

## **What is Memorandum of Understanding?**

A memorandum of understanding is a document describing a bilateral or multilateral agreement between parties. It expresses a convergence of will between the parties, indicating an intended common line of action. It is often used in cases where parties either do not imply a legal commitment or in situations where the parties cannot create a legally enforceable agreement.

**Constitution:** NGO's have multiple options to select the form of constitution. The different forms of the constitution which can be chosen are as below:

1. Public Charitable Trust.
2. Society.

Each form of the constitution has its own enactment and the provisions contained therein would apply to the respective form.

**1. Trust:** It is a legal arrangement in which a person holds property for the sake of some other person, created for the purpose of charitable and religious purposes. Trust can be constituted by Trust deed. In the case of formation of trust, there are no specific statues available.

However, Charitable Endowment Act 1890 and Charitable and Religious act 1920 have bearing on the formation of a charitable trust.

To create a **trust**, the property **owner** (called the "trustor," "grantor," or "settlor") transfers legal ownership to a person or institution (called the "trustee") to manage that property for the benefit of another person (called the "beneficiary"). The trustee often receives compensation for his or her management role.

A public charitable trust should be formed only when one wishes to make an endowment of property for perpetuity and the trustees' desire that this property be used only for specified charitable purposes with close control by the original settlors/trustees.

Main Characteristics of Trust are:

1. Trusts are governed by relevant State Trust Act or Bombay Public Trusts Act
2. 2 persons are required to form a Trust, with no upper limit.
3. Trust is set up by a Trust Deed on non-judicial stamp paper worth some percentage of the value of the trust property.
4. Trust Deed contains the aims and objectives of forming the Trust and the mode of management of the Trust.
5. The composition of the board changes mainly by appointment and not election.
6. Alteration of the objects laid down in the Trust Deed is difficult and only the settler can modify them.
7. The Charities Commissioner has more power to intervene in the affairs of a Trust than in a society.
8. Trust cannot be dissolved easily.

**2. Society:** It is an Association of persons who come together by mutual consent to act jointly for a common purpose. The compliance has to be made under Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act 1975. Minimum 7 members in state level and minimum of 9 members in National level society are required for the formation of society. The requisite documents are to be submitted in the office of the Registrar. After the verification of the documents, a Certificate of Registration is issued along with the certified copy of the Bye-Laws of the Society.

Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act 1975 which allows the registration of entries involved in the benefit of society, i.e. promotion of education, literature, science, religion, charity, social reform, art, crafts, cottage industries, athletics, sports, recreation, public health, social service, cultural activities, the diffusion of useful knowledge or such other useful object with respect to which the State Legislature has power to make laws for the State, which may be prescribed, may be registered under this Act.

Main Characteristics of Society are:

- Societies are governed by Societies Registration Act
- Seven persons are required to form a society with no upper limit
- Members have to file a MoU on non-judicial stamp paper, setting out the objectives of the society before the registrar of societies in the state in which the society is set up.
- The legal requirements are much simpler than in the case of a trust.
- Complete renewal of members is possible and objects can be modified easily
- Easier to wind up a Society
- Society has a more democratic set up with membership and an elected body to manage the Society

- Due to democratic procedures, the Society can be taken over by elements opposed to the founding members

**Management and Administration:** Every registered Society shall have a registered office to which all communications and notices may be addressed and shall file with the Registrar. Date of registration of Society is to be displayed on the outside of its registered office. The registered Society shall maintain register containing the names, addresses and occupations of its members. The registered Society shall have a committee of not less than three members to manage its affairs and shall file with the Registrar a copy of the register maintained from time to time and intimate the change among the members of the Committee.

Society shall keep proper accounts and at the expiration of the Financial year, prepare a receipts & expenditure accounts, balance sheet and get it audited by the qualified auditors. The same is to be placed in the General body for its approval. Submit the audited accounts to the Registrar along with the declaration to the effect that the Society has been carrying on business or has been in operation during the financial year.

**Registration of Society:** For the purpose of registration of a Society, there shall be filed with Registrar of the District which the society is formed by a member of the committee of the society or by any person duly authorized by the committee in this behalf,

1. A memorandum specifying,
  - a. The name of the Society
  - b. Objects of the society
  - c. Names, address and occupations of the members of the committee

No Society shall be registered by a name, which is undesirable, like obscene and decorum or likely to promote disharmony or feelings of enmity or hatred or ill-will between different religious, racial, language or regional groups or castes or

communities or identical with, or too nearly resembles, the name by which a Society in existence has been previously registered. The word like “Union” or “State” ca not be used.

2. Bye-Laws of the Society.
3. Election Notifications
4. Copies of the General body held
5. Auditor report
6. Declaration that the Society is operational

What is the advantage of Income tax in respect of Trusts/Society?

**Income Tax Department treats both Trusts and Societies** similarly and the procedure for Exemption of Income or Grant of 80G Certificates is same under both entities: we should see the benefits of forming both Trusts and Societies separately so that a decision can be made as to which formation to go for.

### **What is 12AA Registration?**

12AA Registration is a **onetime registration that can exempt Income Tax of an organisation**. After this registration, all income can not be taxed. The application form which is used to request for 12AA Registration is **form 10A**.

### **What is Registration u/s 80G?**

The charitable organizations also need to apply for registration u/s 80G of the income tax act. It provides deduction while computing the total income in the hands of the donor. Further, section 80G applies only to charitable trusts or institution. It does not apply to religious trust or institutions. No deduction shall be allowed to the done under section 80G in respect of donation of any sum exceeding INR 2,000 unless such some is paid by any mode other than cash.

The trusts or society can be registered as above depending on the place

Both will have to get 12A, 12AA and 80G to obtain Benefits

### **What are the Benefits of Registration u/s 12A of Income Tax Act, 1961?**

**Section 11 and 12 of the Income Tax Act provides exemptions to NGO’s. Registration u/s 12A** is a pre-condition and mandatory requirement for claiming those exemptions. NGO’s having 12A registration enjoy tax benefits.

“It is important to note here that notwithstanding the fact that trust, society and section 8 companies are registered as per their respective acts, the registration under section 12A is necessary to claim exemption under Income Tax Act.”

The various benefits of Section 12A/12AA AND 80G registration are enumerated as below:

- 1) The income applied for charitable or religious purpose will be considered as application of income i.e. expenditure incurred for charitable or religious purpose will be allowed while computing income of the trust.
- 2) The benefit of accumulating or setting aside of income not exceeding 15% for charitable or religious purpose will be available.
- 3) The accumulation of income, which is deemed as application of income as per section 11(2), shall not be included in the total income.
- 4) NGO’s receives various grants from government and other agencies. They are eligible to get grants and financial funding from various agencies. These agencies generally make grants to 12A registered NGO’s.
- 5) Benefit in Section 80G registration. NGO’s have to apply separately for Section 80G registration.

It is important to note that when registration is granted under section 12A, it does not mean that section 80G approval is to be given i.e. registration under section 12A will not provide automatic approval under section 80G. Section 80G applies only to charitable trusts or institution. It does not apply to religious trust or institutions. ■

The IMA-NHB TNSB EC meeting was held on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2020 at the RKN Beach Resort, Puducherry. The meeting was held to discuss various issues faced by the associate hospitals and determine a solution to the same. NHB chairman Dr. B. Sridhar. State President Dr. C. N. Raja gave an overview of the issues to be taken for discussion. Dr. A. K. Ravi Kumar also showed an insight into the problems faced by small and medium hospitals.

The first major issue faced by NHB was briefed by NHB secretary, Dr. S. G. Balamurugan, the difficulty in getting accurate Database for NHB records. The issue raised was that member Hospitals do not cooperate with NHB in providing correct contact details in regard with representing Doctor's mobile number and email ID. The resolution agreed upon was that the city branch officers will coordinate with NHB to provide valid data of their regional members with respect to their cities/districts. The state secretary Dr. Ravi Kumar also agreed to send email to all the branches in this regard.

The next issue discussed was in respect to Clinical Establishment Act (CEA), India. The state president and Secretary had met the representatives of the Directorate of Medical and Rural Health Services and presented the issues and harassment faced by our associate members with regard to obtaining The Certificate of registration of clinical establishment. The Directorate of Medical and Rural Health Services assured a resolution will be raised and the same will be communicated to all the The Joint Director for Health and Services (JDHS). It was advised that all associate members submit only the Biomedical Waste Disposal Certificate to the JDHS in regard to the same. It was also advised to maintain a good working relationship with the JDHS. In continuation to Biomedical Waste management it was suggested by NHB secretary Dr. S. G. Balamurugan that IMA should take up Ramanathapuram district and develop a Biomedical Waste management unit for the district. It was proposed that this project would benefit both associate members of that district and also develop better standards in healthcare for the district. The members through debate and with Presidents strong advice agreed to move forward with the project.

Minimum wage and fire safety for all associate hospitals were discussed. The past President Dr. S. Kanagasabapathy and immediate past NHB secretary Dr. Karthik Prabu who have recently attended a Government meeting regarding the same suggested that a two tier pay scale be established for qualified nursing staff, one as Rs. 15,000/- inclusive of dearness allowance (DA) and another Rs.9,000/- plus DA with the condition DA should start at zero. For all other categories of staff "the pay scales of Shop and establishments Act" should be considered. As for Fire safety until a relief is reached in the court of law the association President will meet with Director general of Fire safety and discuss an intermediate relief regarding obtaining of fire safety certificate for small and medium hospitals.

Few other issues discussed are the Formation of IMA Task force, this was let to the scope of the local branches. The issue of Public Building Act and the requirements to take building license and fire safety certificate before applying for NDRC & Spirits licence was discussed and both president and secretary agreed to take it up with the local administration ministry immediately.

Many fruitful decisions were made with regard to the issues faced by the associate hospitals and its members. With more active participation from our members we are sure that any issue faced will be a small and easy hurdle to cross. As long as we are together we are strong. ■

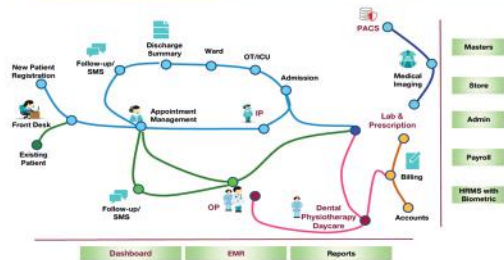
